The following items were discussed:

1. Discuss residential street speed limits. Mayor Kennon proposed lowering residential street speed limits from 25 miles per hour to 15 miles per hour. Councilmember Johnson suggested increased signage. City Administrator Ken Grimes asked that Council permit staff to discuss and return with a plan for consideration.
2. Discuss recreation membership rates. Rates for Orange Beach and Ono Island residents will stay the same. Non-resident rates will increase.
3. Resolution authorizing the execution of a software license agreement with Station Automation Inc., doing business as PSTrax, for Narcotics Tracking Software for the Fire Department.
4. Resolution reappointing members to the Gulf Shores and Orange Beach Tourism Board of Directors.
5. Set a public hearing date for an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 172, the Zoning Ordinance, Case No. 0604-PUD-21, Mississippi Avenue PUD. Public hearing set for July 6, 2021.

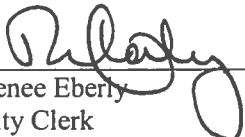
