The Orange Beach City Council met to review potential items for the July 20, 2021, agenda.

The following items were discussed:

1. Resolution authorizing the execution of a task order with Thompson Engineering, Inc., to perform design, bid, and construction administration services for repair/replacement of the Perdido Pass Seawall Park following Hurricane Sally in an amount not to exceed \$104,000.
2. Resolution authorizing execution of a task order with Sawgrass Consulting, LLC, to provide civil design, land surveying, construction engineering and inspection for a Waterfront Boardwalk from Sail Camp to GTs on the Bay in an amount not to exceed \$28,500.
3. Resolution authorizing execution of a task order with Sawgrass Consulting, LLC, to provide civil design, land surveying, construction engineering and inspection for Rosemary Trail Cabins in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.
4. Resolution authorizing a franchise for Kristi Lacole Bishop Hoop, dba Bama Beach Shuttle, to operate a shuttle service within the city limits and police jurisdiction of the City of Orange Beach.
5. Resolution authorizing the execution of a professional services agreement with McCollough Architecture, Inc., for architectural services.
6. Set a public hearing date for an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 172, the Zoning Ordinance, Case No. 0608-PUDA-21, Sunset Park, Lot 25, 4696 Casablanca Dr., Porch Encroachment. Public hearing set for August 3, 2021.

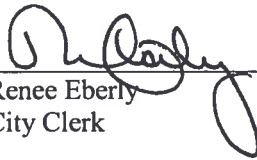
Public Comments:

1. Pam Muller submitted a question through Facebook asking about who to call at the city regarding people cutting down trees on the weekend. 2. Mayor Kennon reported the city is in the process of repairing or purchasing replacements for the two pumps that are down in Bear Point after the recent heavy rains. Staff reported that Bear Point received six to eight inches in comparison to the three inches recorded at City Hall.
3. Ken Grimes, City Administrator, stated that local youth award recipients from this past Lemonade Day will be recognized at the next City Council meeting on July 20th.

4. Mayor Kennon announced that the new Adult Fitness Center is now open.
