1. Appoint voting delegate for the Alabama League of Municipalities Annual Convention and the Alabama Municipal Insurance Corporation Annual Membership Meeting to be held in Tuscaloosa, May 11-14, 2022.
2. Resolution authorizing execution of a professional services agreement for engineering services for the Canoe Trail Site Repairs.
3. Resolution authorizing repair and modifications to the Dolphin Sculpture known as "Hope" in an amount not to exceed \$49,000.

Public Comments:

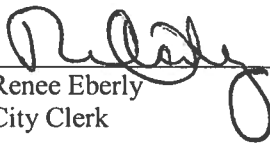
1. Mary Lou Sanford Torbert, owner/operator of Nauti Bites, a food concessionaire who operate from a marine vessel, stated that she is licensed to do business in Pensacola but had heard that she is not allowed to be licensed in Orange Beach. Mayor Kennon explained that the current elected officials will probably never allow commercial enterprises on the beach because of their philosophy to balance conservation and recreation.
