Public Comments

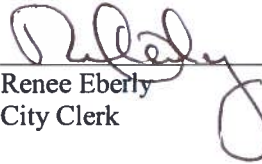
1. Jeb Smith, 5504 East Perdido Avenue, thanked Jim Bibby for the use of the Wharf Amphitheatre for church service.
