5. Resolution appropriating funds to the Orange Beach Education Foundation, Inc., in the amount of \$6,012.20.
6. Resolution authorizing execution of a software service agreement with Locality Media, Inc., dba First Due Size Up, for planning, tracking, and communication services for the Fire Department.

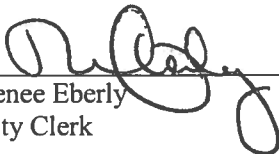
Public Comments:
