1. Discuss proposals by Human Resources Management, Inc., for HR Assessment and Executive Search.
2. Resolution authorizing execution of a rental agreement with Sharp Electronics Corporation for a copier for the HR Division through State Bid.
3. Resolution authorizing approval of a proposed wetland permit application by Abaco Orange Beach LLC.
4. Resolution authorizing the execution of a performance agreement with Joan Hill for water aerobics instruction at the Aquatics Center.
5. Resolution awarding the bid for Justice Center Roof and Fascia Replacement.

Public Comments:

1. Woody Speed, Environmental Specialist, showed pictures from a boat trip with state and local representatives demonstrating the benefits of the estuary program.
