The following items were discussed:

1. Discuss request by Harbor Ridge HOA for the city to accept for maintenance a portion of Saint Lucia Drive and sanitary sewer system. Council questioned the benefit to the city and said that it is difficult to say yes to this request when a similar request from Cypress Village was denied. Sharon Donnelly, Harbor Ridge HOA President, had a brief conversation with Ford Handley, Finance Director, regarding one resident who is habitually late on their sewer bill. Mr. Handley explained that if the city approves the request, the subdivision will become approximately 22 separate sewer billing accounts rather than one account, and it will fall to the city to pursue delinquent accounts rather than the HOA. Ms. Donnelly made a final plea to City Council to consider the request.
2. Resolution awarding the bid for Ballistic Vests.

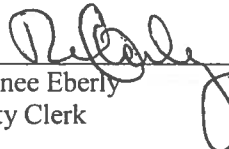
Public Comments:
